Has close contact with any person who, after the end of the period of national mobilization for the suppression of communist rebellion, has been convicted by a court, or is currently wanted in an unresolved case, for the offense of internal rebellion or external aggression, or for offenses under the National Security Act, the Anti-Infiltration Act, the National Intelligence Work Act, the Classified National Security Information Protection Act, the Act Governing Relations between the People of the Taiwan Area and the Mainland Area, or the Act Governing Relations with Hong Kong and Macau.			
13. Has been induced or forced by a foreign government, authorities from the Mainland Area, Hong Kong, or Macau, their representative bodies, political organizations, institutions, or groups, or persons dispatched by them to carry out actions that harm national security or the country's significant interests.			
14. The individual, any blood relatives within three degrees, stepparents, spouse or cohabitant, or the spouse's or cohabitant's parents have held positions in political parties or military, administrative, or other political organizations, institutions, or groups overseas or in the Mainland Area, Hong Kong, or Macau.
